

Academic Performance 2014 - 2015

In a Year Group of 49 pupils, 44 candidates sat the King Edward's School / King Edward VI High School for Girls examinations and 31 (73%) were offered places. This is 6% up compared to last year.

49 candidates sat the Local Authority Grammar Schools examinations and 35 (71%) were offered places. This figure is lower compared to 2014 because 20% of grammar school places were offered to low income families (Pupil Premium).

33 scholarships were awarded to 25 children.
